PRAISING

Samuel 22:47, 50 - Praise

47 The LORD lives! Praise be to my Rock! Exalted be my God, the Rock, my Savior!

50 Therefore I will praise you. O LORD, among the nations; I will sing the praises of your name

Revelation 5:12, 13

In a loud voice they sang: "Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise!" 13 ... "To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be praise and honor and glory and power, for ever and ever!"

36 Praise be to the LORD, the God of Israel, from everlasting to everlasting. Then all the people said "Amen" and "Praise the LORD.

Psalms 9:1-2 - Praise & Thanksgiving

I will praise you, O LORD, with all my heart; I will tell of all your wonders. 2 I will be glad and rejoice in you; I will sing praise to your name, O Most High.

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 - Praise & Thanksgiving

Rejoice always, 17 pray continually, 18 give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

1 Peter 1:3

Praise be to the God and Father of our LORD Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.

Psalms 9:11

Sing praises to the LORD, enthroned in Zion; proclaim among the nations what he has done.

Psalms 13:6

Psalms 16:7

I will praise the LORD, who counsels me; even at night my heart instructs me.
